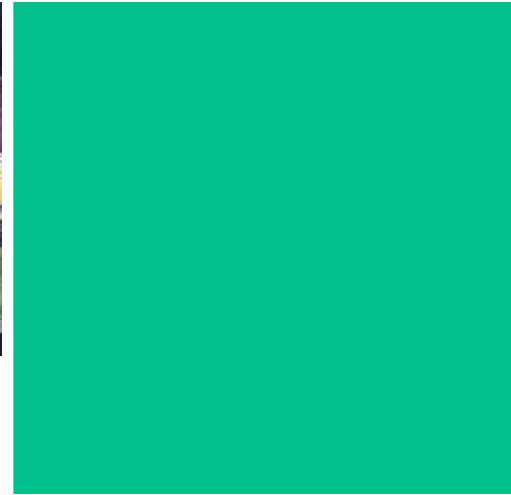

## LendingTree Bowl Art Contest

1. Program will begin September 10<sup>th</sup> and ends on November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
2. Participants must be in High School or Junior High School in Mobile and/or Baldwin County.
3. Participants can obtain the official Art Contest entry form by visiting the LendingTree Bowl website, [lendingtreebowl.com](http://lendingtreebowl.com) and clicking on the Art Contest link located under community.
4. Participants must create individual projects, no group entries.
5. Theme: The Gulf Coast: What Brings Us Together
6. Student must put their name, teacher's name, school, county and grade, on the backside bottom right corner of the artwork, so that it may be identified.
7. The format of the Art must include:
  - Paper Size 11" x 14"
  - Images can be vertical or landscape
  - Free art format, should be 2D
  - NO 3D of any kind or Sculpture
  - NO computer generated, includes graphic design
  - NO photography
8. The completed **entry form** and **art** must be attached (by tape or paperclip) and, please write name, phone number, teacher, grade and school on the back of the artwork as well, when submitted to the LendingTree Bowl Office (1000 Hillcrest Road, Suite 115, Mobile, Alabama 36695.)
9. Entries must be brought to the LendingTree Bowl office by November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 before 4 P.M.
10. Entries will be judged on: art quality, theme, creativity, and originality.
11. Limit one entry per student. Students MUST enter artwork done specifically for this art contest.
12. Student or Teacher may mat, mount or shrink wrap, but matting or mounting is not required. Shrink-wrap is only required if artwork contains a messy medium.
13. The three categories of this competition are as follows: 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grades.
14. The winners will be announced via social media and awarded 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place for each category (with a total of 9 winners). Awards will be distributed to the student at their school.
15. Select game tickets to LendingTree Bowl will be made available to the 9 finalist/winners and their families providing fans are allowed in attendance. In this case, meals, transportation, and lodging to attend these events are the sole responsibility of the finalist/winner and the guest they choose to bring.
16. Cash prize will be awarded to the students' school's art program. In addition, the student will receive LendingTree Bowl tickets (see 15) and a prize package. Winning entries/students will be featured in the LendingTree Bowl Program. The artwork will be displayed in various locations. Due to Covid-19, the Bowl's award banquet is not guaranteed to occur. In lieu of this, a virtual announcement will be made to honor the winning students.
17. LendingTree Bowl and any employees, judges, volunteers, or additional sponsor associated with the above listed corporations are not responsible for late, stolen, or misdirected entries. Winning entries will become property of the art contest and displayed at LendingTree Bowl Headquarters, etc.
18. Entries not selected as finalist/winner can be picked up from the LendingTree Bowl office beginning Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 between 9 am and 4 pm. (Please call first to ensure the office is open)
19. The odds of winning depend on the number of participants.
20. All Federal, State, and Local taxes will be the responsibility of the winners.
21. By submitting this entry, entrant grants the LendingTree Bowl the unconditional right to use the name, photograph and artwork in connection with any article, publicity, or press releases without further compensation. The prizes must be accepted as awarded and are non-transferable. Sponsors reserve the right to substitute prizes for one of equal or greater value. By entering, entrant agrees to contest rules and all decisions of the judges are final.
